FAQ

How do I buy a brick?

All you have to do is fill out a form and pay for your brick with cash or check.

Where can I get an order form?

You may pick up order forms at MHCNS school, or go to our website at

www.meridianhillscoop.org and print out the form by clicking on the "Brick Order Form" option.



What is the process?

Once an order form is completed and payment is made, you will receive a confirmation e-mail thanking you for your order and confirming your information for engraving. MHCNS is not responsible for errors due to incorrectly submitted forms, so please proof all copy after receiving confirmation from our Alumni Chair. Please make sure you include your e-mail address for these important correspondence.

Your brick will be held for installation during the Outdoor Workday in late August of 2010, only if MHCNS meets our pre-sale goal of selling 120 bricks before July 2nd. If we are not able to meet our pre-sale goal before the July 2nd deadline we will continue to sell bricks throughout the 2010-2011 school year & install the brick pavers in the Spring or Fall of 2011.

If we meet our pre-sale goals you will be invited to our dedication ceremony at our 50th Anniversary Celebration on Saturday, October 8, 2010, where you can see your brick in place! We can not guarantee that all engraved bricks will be installed before the ceremony, but it is best if you place your order before July 2, 2010.

Can I buy a brick later?

Yes and No. In order for us to proceed with the brick pathway Meridian Hills Co-Op needs to pre-sell 120 bricks to assure we have the funds to build this beautiful pathway. Our hopes are to have this pathway installed in time for our 50th Anniversary Celebration on Saturday, October 8, 2010.

Can I purchase more than one brick?

Absolutely Yes! Please make sure you fill a form out for each brick you are purchasing and staple the order forms together.

How much does a brick cost?

2 Lines of Text - \$50 - 4 X 8 Brick - (18 Characters Per Line, with Spacing & Punctuation Count as a Character)

3 Lines of Text - \$65 - (same size brick and character rules)

4 Lines of Text - \$80 - (same size brick and character rules)

Can I specify where my brick is placed?

We will place the bricks to fill the design. It will be difficult to guarantee a specific location. If you purchase multiple bricks and would like them installed together we will do our best to keep them connected.

What can I engrave on the brick?

Options are many. See our display or website for examples. MHCNS reserves the right to review all text for appropriateness and to decline those that do not reflect the spirit of the project or a learning environment. Any requests for engraving deemed inappropriate will be rejected and your check will be returned. MHCNS is not responsible for errors due to incorrectly submitted forms.
